Appendix 4 ILAE Financial statements

The League foresaw a treasurer as early as 1910. At the outset, the ILAE's funds would have been limited to what it collected from individual members. By 1912, the organisation was discussing procedures for collecting dues from its national 'committees'. But we know nothing of the

accounting system. The first official financial statements did not appear until following the ILAE's collapse with the onset of the First World War and its reconstitution in 1935.
