<p>I am an academic pediatric epileptologist working at Peking University People's Hospital in Beijing. I have dedicated myself in clinical medicine and research, especially in pediatric epileptology. I have held several research projects on childhood epilepsy and febrile seizures, pediatric refractory epilepsies in particular. I am very active in patient caring program. As the director of pediatrics at Peking University First Hospital, I established the first CAAE Caring Center for Epileptic Children in October 2011, and built up the first Tuberous Sclerosis Clinic in China. I established another CAAE patient caring program at the 1st year of my new position, Director of Pediatrics, Peking University People's Hospital. A monthly health education program has been carried out over the past 2 years. My research interests include etiology of the epilepsies, as well as clinical observation of the new treatments in childhood refractory epilepsy. Over 120 peer reviewed papers have been published.</p>
